Learning about the Liturgical Year adds an extra rich dimension to the teaching of R.E and to the prayer life of the school. This section is meant to provide some ideas; people and events, which may be incorporated into the lessons and prayer times.

April 2023

Pope Francis' prayer request is for a culture of peace and non violence: We pray for the spread of peace and non-violence, by decreasing the use of weapons by States and citizens.

The first eight days of the month fall during the season of Lent which is represented by the liturgical colour violet or purple. The remainder of April falls during the Easter season which is represented by the liturgical colour white: the colour of light, a symbol of joy, purity and innocence (absolute or restored).
