Reflection

Beloved Friends, Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In his Homily on Sunday 18th of May (the Birthday of Saint Pope John Paul II) at the beginning of his Pontificate, our new Holy Father Pope Leo XVI said: "In these days, we have experienced intense emotions ..." How right was he. From 14th February, when Pope Francis went into hospital, through to his time of illness, his death, days of mourning, the period of interregnum, the conclave, the white smoke, the election of the new Holy Father, we have moved from sadness to joy. Our Faith has been reawakened, refreshed and nourished. During these days, with our eyes and hearts fixed on Rome, on TV, and in prayer, I have felt so proud of being a Catholic seeing the Holy Spirit at work in his Church.

The Month of May this year for our Church has been one of great witness and expression of profound Faith. Recognising the importance of this Month of May in our devotion to our Lady, you would have noticed that Pope Leo XVI ended his address at the balcony by inviting us to pray the Regina Caeli. It is sung from Easter Vigil through Pentecost Sunday. Regina caeli, laetare, alleluia; quia quem meruisti portare, alleluia; resurrexit sicut dixit, alleluia; ora pro nobis Deum, alleluia. Translation: Queen of heaven, rejoice, alleluia; for He whom thou was chosen to bear, alleluia; has risen as He said, alleluia; pray for us to God, alleluia.

We also have three other traditional Anthems to our Lady: Alma Redemptoris Mater: Sung from the first Sunday of Advent until the Feast of the Purification on February 2 (the original ending date of the Christmas season), this prayer tells of Gabriel's announcement, and of Mary's divine motherhood. Ave Regina Caelorum: This anthem is sung from after Purification (February 2 or Candlemas) until Easter Vigil. Salve Regina is sung as a seasonal anthem from the day after Pentecost Sunday until the first Sunday of Advent; and at different times during the year.



During these busy exam season for your schools, find solace in praying the Regina Caeli. It is such a beautiful prayer.

I entrust you to our Lady Seat of Wisdom and of Good Counsel. May she support us all at our time of need, and be there for us when we need refreshment, light and peace. Amen.

Archbishop's Appeal Grant 2025

What is the Archbishop's Appeal Grant?

The Archbishop's Appeal is a fundraising appeal that takes place across parishes in the Archdiocese of Southwark each year. Launched in November 2022, this fundraising effort seeks to invest faith, hope, love, and charity into the missionary work of the Archdiocese in three key areas: Youth and Evangelisation, Social Outreach and Clergy Care. Funds are collected and held centrally by the Archdiocese of Southwark and ring-fenced for the Archbishop's Appeal, a portion of which is designated to be granted back to parishes and schools to support their local work.

Grants of up to £5,000 are available to support innovative projects taking place in Southwark parishes, schools, commissions, and other Catholic entities working alongside the Archdiocese, which seek to enhance one or more of the key missionary areas: Youth/Evangelisation or Social Outreach.




