The role does not require you to be a parent or to have experience of the education sector.

As a Foundation Governor you represent the Archbishop in his ministry as the first teacher of the Diocese. A Foundation Governor must therefore be a practising Catholic who is in full sacramental communion with the Church.

As part of the application process, your Parish Priest will be requested to provide a reference to this effect.
